



MEDICATION DISPOSAL DROP BOX

A SERVICE FOR YUKON RESIDENTS

The City of Yukon in partnership with Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics (OBN) has provided a Medication Disposal Drop Box located in the lobby at the Police Department at 100 S Ranchwood Blvd.

The program aims to prevent medication misuse and abuse by providing a secure, environmentally safe means for residents to dispose of unwanted drugs. Disposing of your outdated or unwanted medications by throwing them away in the trash or flushing them down the toilet or drain can cause pollution of water supplies and endanger animals, according to the EPA. Medications collected from drop box locations are incinerated at a waste to energy plant, producing usable energy to help power homes and businesses.

This program is free, and the drop box is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week in the Police Department's lobby. This drop box is for medications only and does not accept syringes, liquids, or inhalers.
