Minutes of January 5, 19160

The City Council of the City of Yukon met in regular session at 8:00 A.M. at the City Hall.

PRESENT: Councilmen Frank, Greene, Seikel, Turner and Mayor Belisle.

ABSENT: None.

The invocation was given by Reverend Greene.

Due to a long agenda, a motion was made by Councilman Frank and seconded by Councilman Turner to waive the reading of the minutes of the past six meetings Until a later meeting date. Roll was called with the following result:

Upon a motion made by Councilman Seikel and seconded by Councilman Frank, Ted Farris was awarded the contract on his bid for StandPipe to use new and used steel and to remove the water tower from grade school grounds two feet below surface. After all bidders were asked to leave the room, roll was called with the following result:

Davis guarantee.
