1. Consider approval of an agreement with Lowe's Home Centers, Inc. for the City to make improvements to SH 92, from I-40 south to 1000' south of 10th Street, and 500' east and west of SH 92 on 10th Street

A motion was made by Council member Rundel, seconded by Vice Mayor Vinson, to approve the agreement with Lowe's Home Centers, Inc. for the City to make improvements to SH 92, from I-40 south to 1000' south of 10th Street, and 500' east and west of SH 92 on 10th Street.

Vice Mayor Vinson asked what the time frame was for this project.

City Manager stated it was to be completed by April 1, 2001, which would be the same as Lowe's opening date. City Manager stated the City of Yukon could pay up to \$330,000 as their share, but due to some contingencies, it might be lower.

Vice Mayor Vinson asked when they would start.

City Manager advised they would begin immediately, with the actual work beginning within three months. He advised that Staples is ready to begin construction now. City Manager said that also the plan-in-hand for this hospital will be presented this Friday.

Mayor Friesen asked if this project could be completed in 7 ½ months.

City Manager advised it could be, but that the negotiations with Oklahoma City might take a little longer, but that the contract with the Wrights will be on the June 6th agenda.

Mayor Friesen asked about the signalization.

City Manager stated they will be placed at 10th Street and Highway 92, and at hospital Drive and West End Pointe Drive.

City Manager stated they will go ahead and do all the signalization at once, as this area will

be expanding shortly.

Council Member Jurgensen asked if it will go to bid before all the contracts are signed.

Jim Crosby, City Manager, advised it would as this is a unit price bid, and if it went out for bid, it would take an additional 60-90 days to begin.
