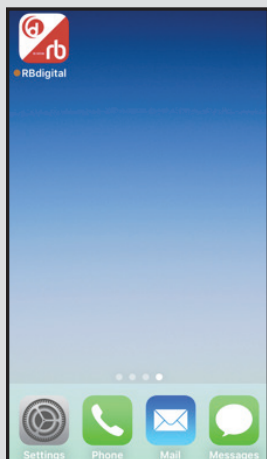


Log in to accounts, set up profiles for each collection, and listen to and read audiobooks, magazines and eBooks—all in one app!

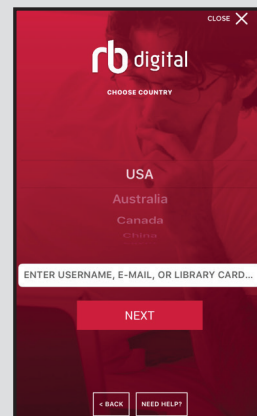
Download and open the RBdigital app.

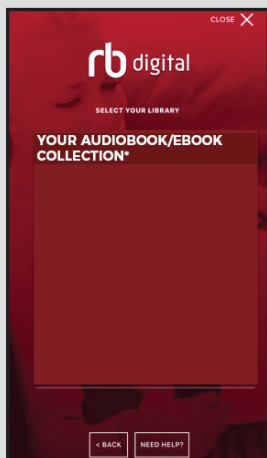
Choose country and enter username, email address or library card number for the collection you wish to access.

(Enter your current log-in information for Zinio for Libraries to access magazine content, or enter your current log-in information for OneClickdigital to access audiobook and eBook content.)



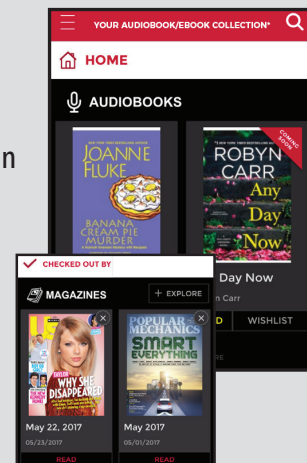

Select your library.



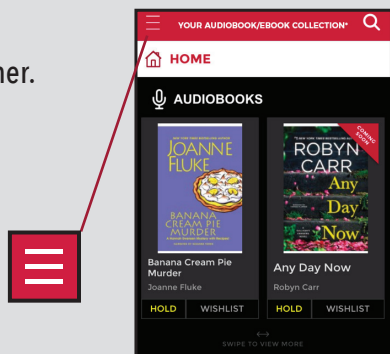

You will be taken to the homepage for the format (audiobooks, eBooks or magazines) of the collection you logged in to.



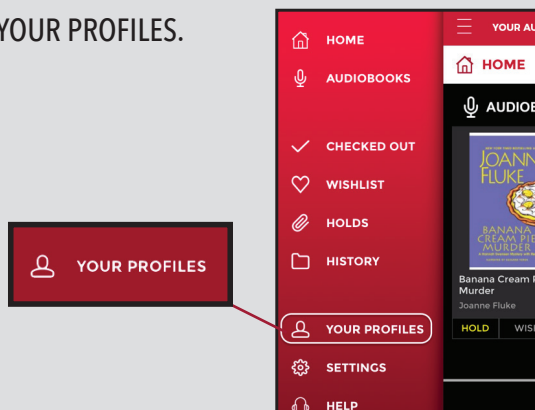

Select MENU icon in upper-left-hand corner.



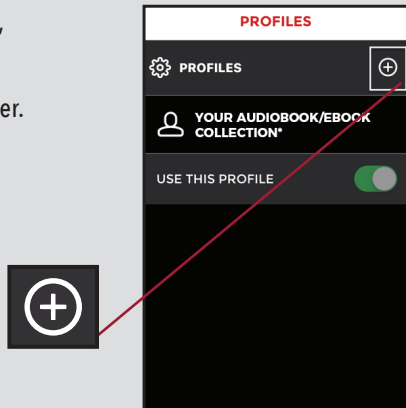

To add another profile, select the plus icon in upper-right-hand corner.

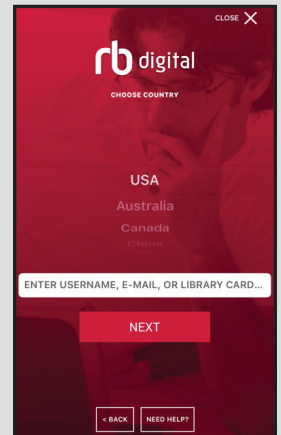

(Ex: Magazines if you already logged in to audiobook/eBook collection.)

Note: If you do not have an account set up for a secondary collection, you'll need to create an account through the browser site.



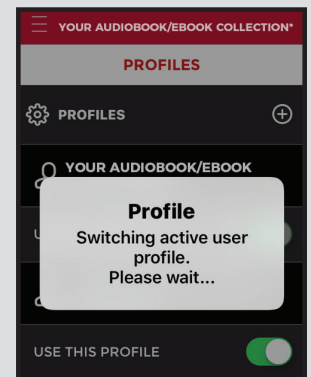

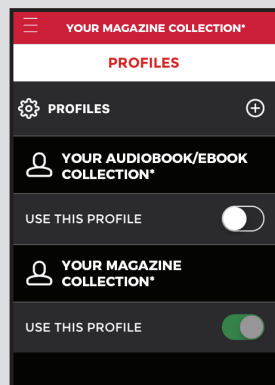
This will switch your profile to your secondary collection.
