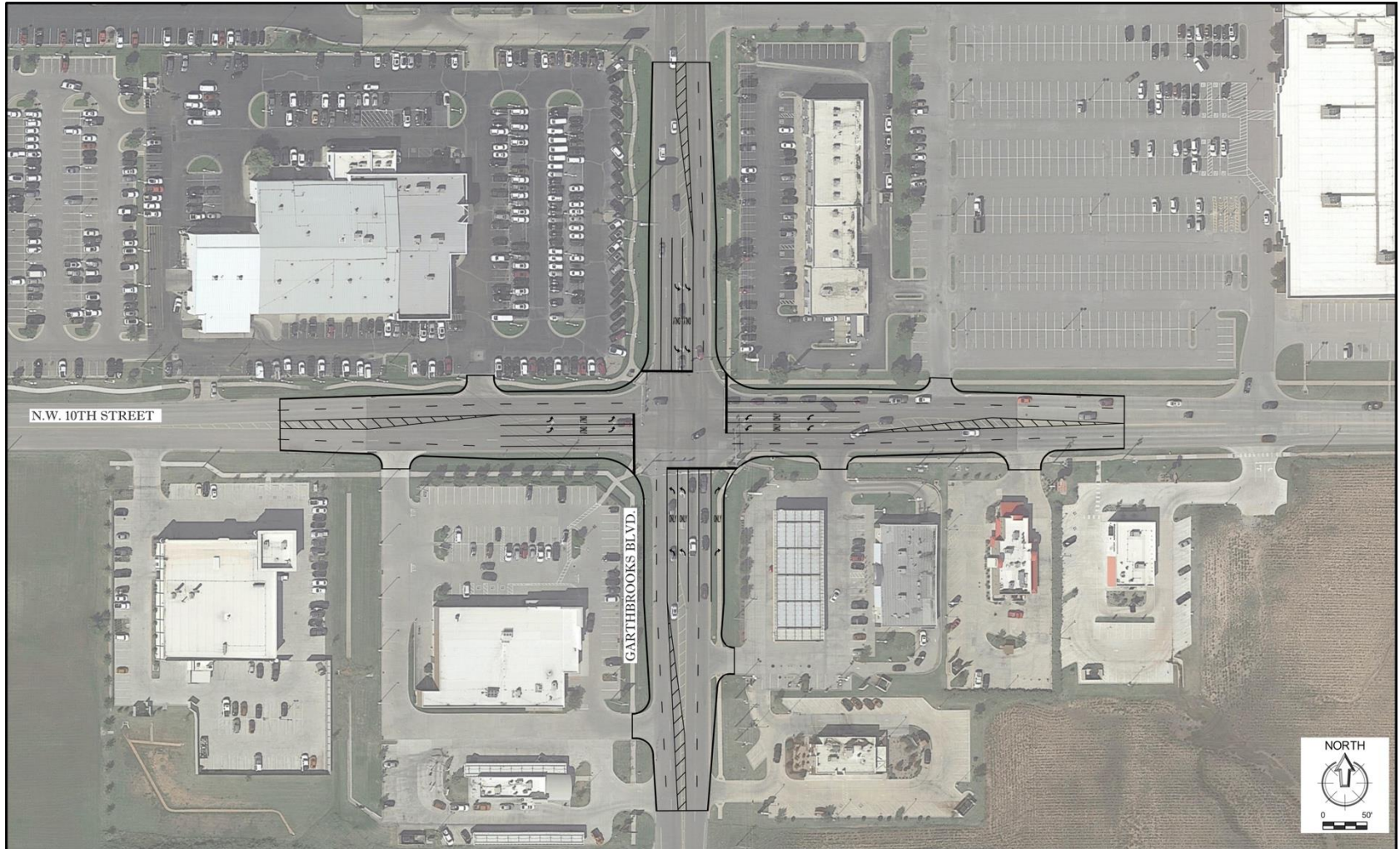
Project: South Yukon Transportation Improvements


Planning and Design activities focused on the following:

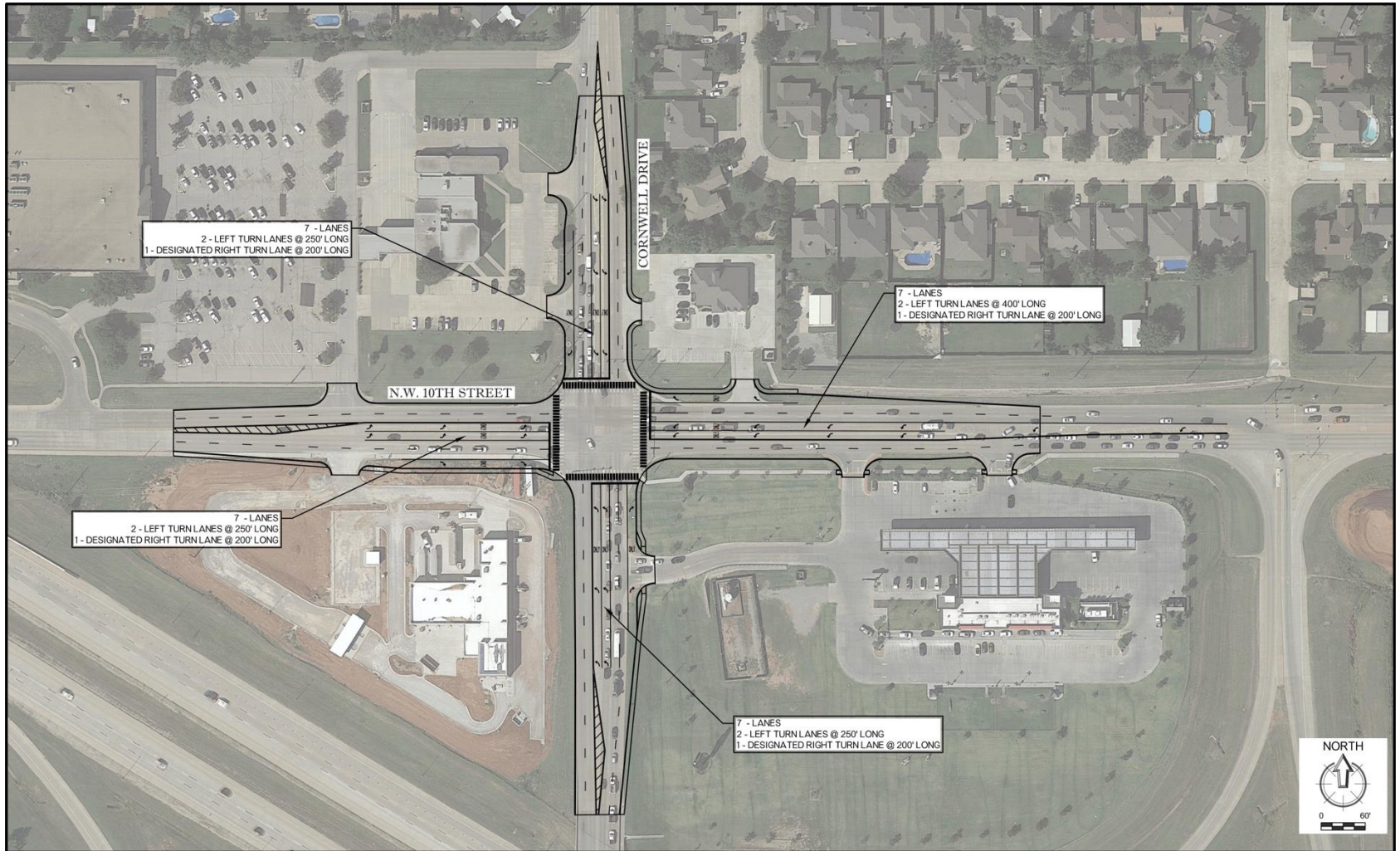
- Roadway improvements along Garth Brooks Boulevard from NW 10th Street to Vandament; adding a 5th lane & multi modal trail
- Improvements at the intersection of NW 10th Street and Cornwell Drive/Czech Hall Road & the intersection of Garth Brooks & NW 10th
- Dual left-turn and dual right-turn lanes on all approaches;
- Updated traffic signals & pedestrian safety





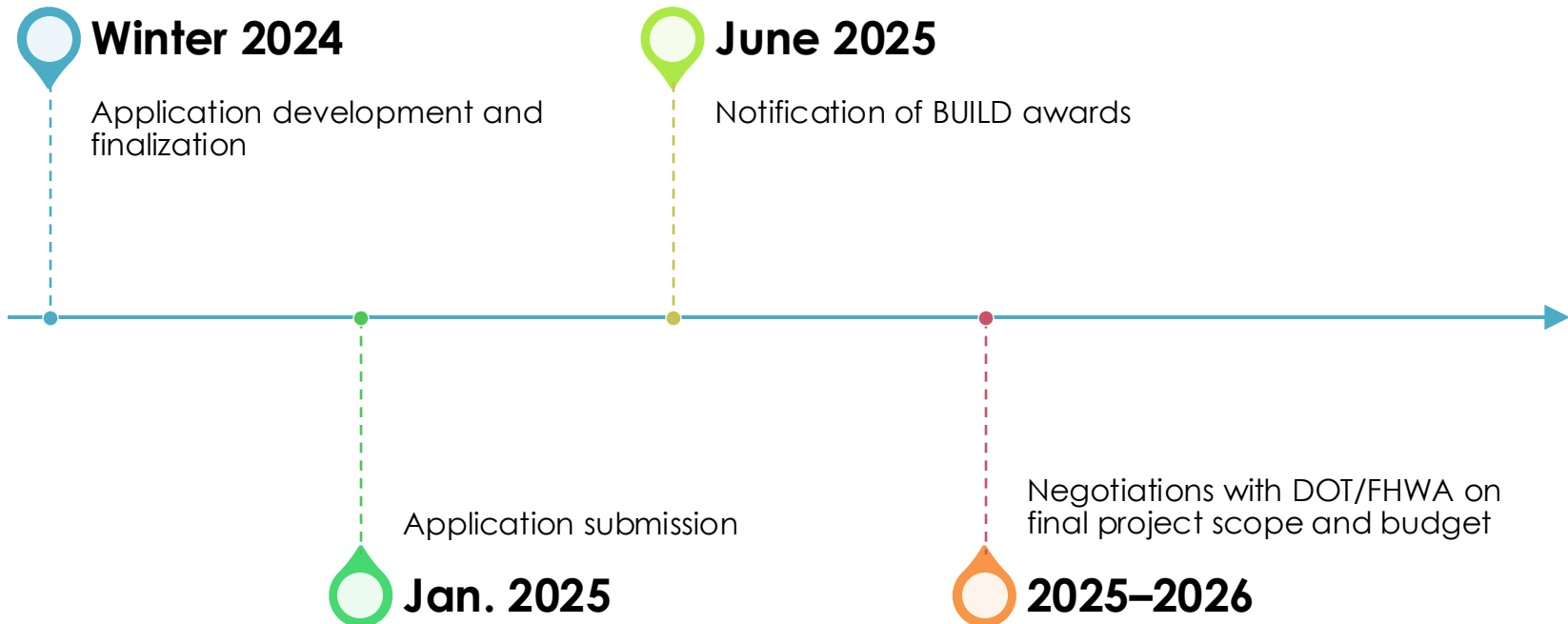
